 - How long and in what capacity person has known the student
 - Description of student's work ethic and level of responsibility
 - Knowledge of any achievements
 - Description of student's character qualities
- Student/Parent meeting (to be arranged upon the completion of the application)

As part of the application process, students and parent(s) will be referred to and expected to read and agree to the Student/Parent Handbook, which contains policies, procedures and expectations for all CORE students.
